- **Supportive Clinical Services**
 - Assist licensed therapists in facilitating individual, group, and family therapy sessions under supervision.
 - Co-facilitate therapeutic groups on relevant topics such as coping skills, emotional regulation, and relapse prevention.
 - Provide one-on-one client support as needed, reinforcing treatment goals and therapeutic interventions.
 - Conduct psychoeducational sessions on topics such as stress management, substance use, or mindfulness.
 - **Administrative Support**
 - Maintain accurate and up-to-date documentation in client files, including session notes, treatment plans, and progress reports, under the supervision of a licensed therapist.
 - Help schedule therapy sessions, family meetings, and other appointments as required by the treatment plan.
 - **Client Intake and Assessment**
 - Assist in conducting initial assessments and intake interviews with new clients under supervision.
 - Support licensed therapists in administering standardized assessments to evaluate mental health symptoms, substance use, or functioning levels.
 - **Crisis Support and Safety Planning**
 - Provide de-escalation and emotional support to clients experiencing acute distress or crisis, under the guidance of licensed staff.
 - Work closely with the treatment team to identify clients needing additional interventions or a higher level of care.
 - **Collaboration and Communication**
 - Participate in daily, weekly and quarterly team meetings to discuss client progress, treatment interventions, and discharge planning.
 - Maintain communication with clients' families or support systems when appropriate, providing updates and supporting family therapy as needed.
 - **Documentation**
 - Assist in maintaining accurate and timely clinical documentation, including session notes, assessments, treatment plans, progress reports, and discharge summaries.
 - **Client Advocacy and Coordination**
 - Assist in creating and maintaining client treatment plans, ensuring they align with the client's goals and needs.
 - Track client progress and provide reports to the treatment team to inform ongoing care and discharge planning.
 - Coordinate with outside agencies, outpatient programs, and other providers for client referrals or post-discharge support.
